



Coverage Area

WAZT is a network of seven FCC Licensed Class A television stations and television translators strategically placed to cover a majority of the viewers in the northern and central areas of Virginia's Shenandoah Valley!

Our recent addition of W14CY, which is a low power station licensed to operate and serve in Charlottesville, is now operational with reports of over-the-air viewership in Albemarle County and the city of Charlottesville, Buckingham County, Greene County, Madison County, Rappahannock County, and as far away as Spotsylvania County. We do not claim full coverage has been achieved in these counties, but we continue to regularly receive reports of new viewers.

All programs and commercial matter are simulcast across the entire network currently covering more than 276,000+ homes. It should also be noted that often homes using direct broadcast satellite often request a switch enabling the reception of local over-the-air broadcasts.
